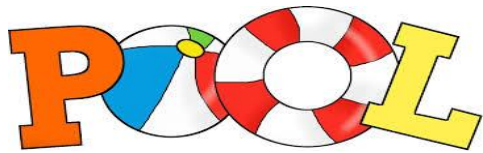

Pool passes are only valid for two years and the majority of the residents will need to have photos retaken. Proof of residency is required. If you rent, your pool pass expires each year. Renters must have a valid Delegation of Rights on file in order to have use of the pool.

Delegation of Rights



2019 DELEGATION OF RIGHTS are due. A current Delegation of Rights must be on file in the clubhouse for any renters wanting to use the pool or rent the clubhouse. These forms were mailed to the owners and need to be updated on an annual basis. No pool passes or clubhouse rentals will be issued to renters without a current form on file.



Please be a good neighbor and take care of our ponds. We appreciate you leaving the rocks alone and not allowing kids to play with them.

Keeping the common areas clean is a neighborly kind gesture. The common area is not a place to dispose of trash, grass clippings, leaves and tree branches.



Paid Assessment Letters are **Required** to Sell Your Home

When selling your home, please have your attorney request a paid assessment letter at least five business days in advance of your closing. The cost of the paid assessment letter is \$40.00. If you need it sooner, a \$20 fee will be added. The request must be in writing and come from your attorney. Please include the closing date, property address, names of the sellers, names & contact info of the buyers and contact information for both attorneys. Fencing Notice

All fences along common areas, whether new or replacements must be approved by the Board of Directors prior to being constructed or repaired.

Article 7.09 of the Steeple Run Declaration of Covenants:

7.09 Alteration of Dwelling Units: No Dwelling Unit Owner shall relocate, heighten, lower or otherwise move, change or construct any fence, wall or patio adjoining or adjacent to the "Common Area" unless consented thereto by the Board of Directors at a Special Meeting called for that purpose. A resolution passed by said Board and signed by the presiding officer shall be procured prior to the commencement of any construction, alteration or change.

Community News

Brush Pick UP



Lisle Township Highway Department offers branch pick-up as a service to residents who live on roads that the township maintains. This program is intended to help homeowners dispose of limbs and branches that do NOT qualify as yard waste. If it is baggable, it is yard waste.

Branch pick-up begins on the 1st Monday of these SIX months: May, June, July, August, September and October.

Please have your bundles at curbside by 6:30 a.m. of the first day of pickup. Often it takes the crew three or more days to service the entire township.

Road Maintenance Scheduled for 2019

The township will be resurfacing Steeple Run Drive, Malibu Lane, Malibu Ct. and Sierra Ln. Approximately 2 inches of surface is removed and replaced with new asphalt.

The project start dates have not yet been determined. The Township will distribute flyers to the homes along these streets about 5 days before construction begins. They will explain the repair process and outline any driving and parking restrictions. The contractor will seal one side of the street at a time, so at least one lane is open for resident traffic. The sealants need up to four hours of drying time before the lane is opened. Residents living on streets where this work will be done will be notified by flyer before the work starts.

Sidewalk Replacement Program



The Highway Department shares the cost of replacing sidewalk squares with homeowners, 50%-50%. The homeowner's half of the cost is \$2.50 per square foot. For example, if the sidewalk square is 5' x 5', then the cost to the resident is \$62.50 per square.

The program requires a deposit of 50% of the cost prior to work and the balance is due when the job is complete.

The deadline to call the Township office is **August 1** to be put on the sidewalk replacement list.
