Steeple Run has implemented an email blast system to communicate special events, newsletter availability, or budget and assessment information.



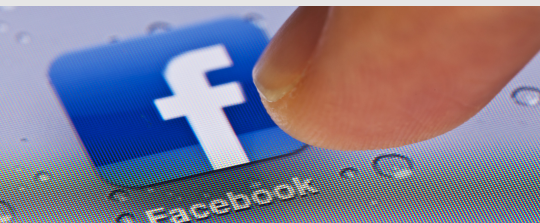

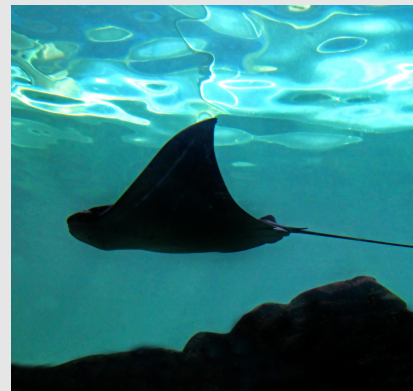

## THE MINI LIBRARY

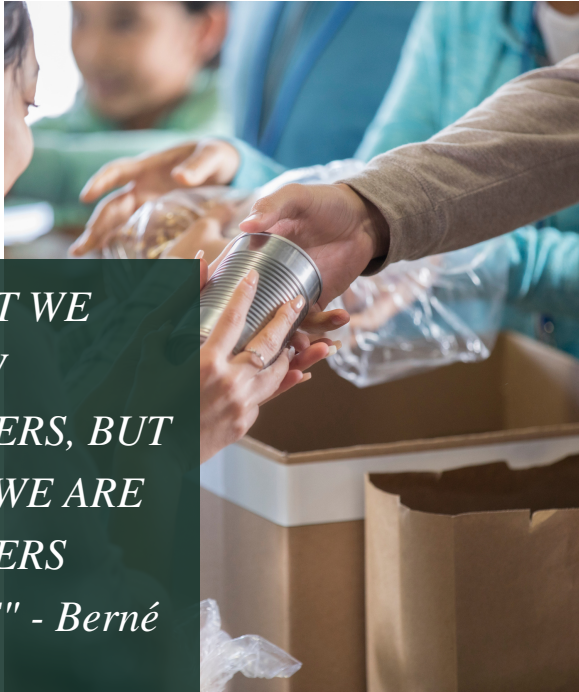
